2005 38ft P-38 Catamaran – “Blue Marble Explorer”

Blue Marble is a 2005 P-38 Lightning Catamaran built by Professional Fishing Systems in Augusta, Georgia, and configured as a high-performance offshore fishing/cruising platform. The vessel features a planing catamaran hull with flared bows, hard chines, and lifting strakes, with solid FRP construction below the waterline and sandwich core above the waterline. Power is provided by four 2020 Yamaha F300NCA outboards rated at 300 HP each, supported by extensive Garmin/Furuno electronics, Optimus steering/joystick docking, a Northern Lights generator, watermaker, cockpit fishing equipment, and overnight accommodations.
