Bieker 53' Fujin

The B53 is a high-performance carbon catamaran built for speed, strength, and versatility. Its resininfused carbon/epoxy construction ensures lightweight durability, while innovative bow shapes reduce windage and boost lift. Designed for racing but equally enjoyable for cruising, Fujin—named after the Japanese Wind God—embodies the B53's cutting-edge performance and sleek design.

Fujin is equipped with a full B&G H5000 racing suite, including radar, AIS, GPS, autopilot, and a Sea Zone 10 navigation computer. The system is supported by dedicated displays for all key crew positions and provides detailed performance and navigation data over an internal Wi-Fi network.
